

Organisation raises funds for victim

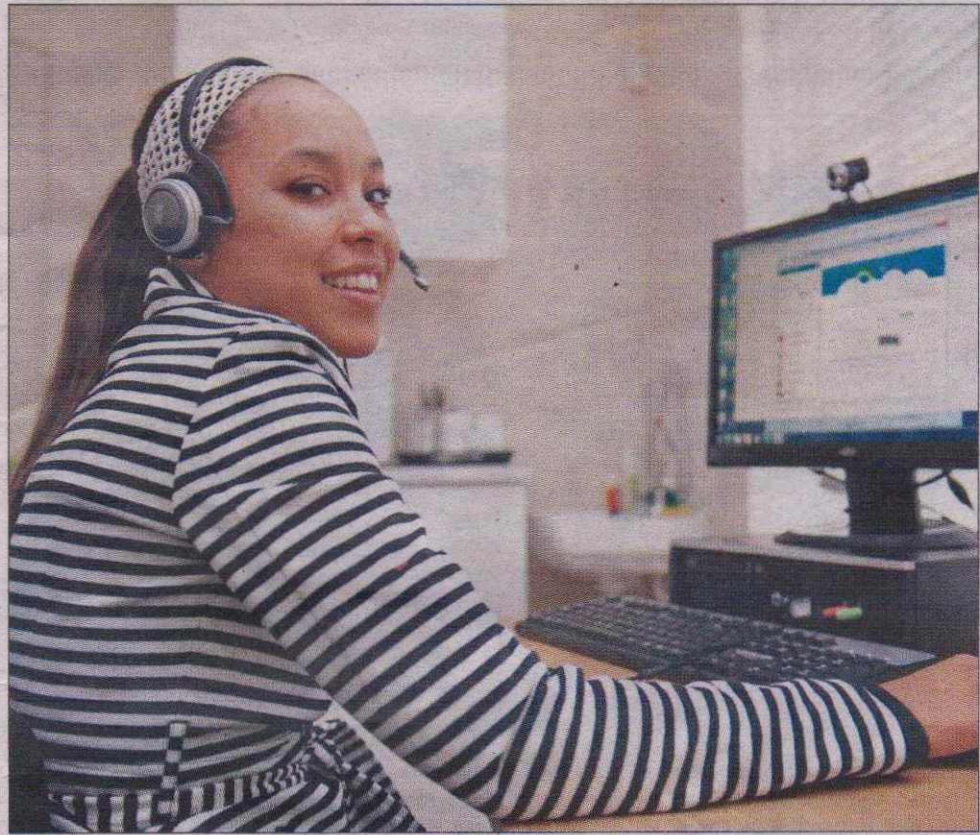

"Isolated by the language barrier and having a stressful teaching job where the pupils do not even respect her, our survivor needs to move out of the environment she is currently in. Our survivor is obviously not coping with the entire trauma and has no support in Korea," said Foord.

The Foundation is keen to help the woman relocate and is appealing to the community for financial support.

"The survivor has to continue working due to financial constraints, but would like to move to another country where she would benefit from a better support system," said Foord.

In order to assist the woman, the Jes Foord Foundation has dedicated its 2013 birthday towards this cause. The event will be held at the Barnyard Theatre and all funds will be used to purchase an air ticket for the survivor to relo-
